Climate Stewardship Policy



1. Preface

Guided by global standards and the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (UNSDG), particularly Goal 13 (Climate Action), we aim to actively contribute to combating the climate crisis.

2. Scope

This policy applies across JWL's operations, facilities, and processes, extending its partnerships with employees, suppliers, contractors, and other stakeholders. It is designed to promote climate stewardship throughout the value chain and beyond.

3. Policy Commitments
