1. Preface

3. Policy Commitments

JWL commits to the following principles and actions to achieve environmental sustainability:

1. Sustainable resource use
 - Optimize the use of raw materials, energy, and water in manufacturing processes.
 - Promote the use of recycled and sustainable materials in product development.
2. Carbon Footprint Reduction
 - Increase energy efficiency in operations and utilize renewable energy sources wherever feasible.
3. Pollution Prevention
 - Implement stringent measures to minimize emissions, waste, and effluents.
 - Ensure compliance with all applicable environmental regulations and standards.
4. Ecosystem Preservation
 - Protect and conserve biodiversity in Company’s operational areas.
